Bequest from Simone Paige

This past month, Subud East Coast received a letter from the law firm of Alexander & Pelli, LLC, informing us of the bequest of Simone Paige to our region. Simone passed on October 4, 2010, and her husband Robert (Joseph) Paige passed on July 12, 2012. As the trust that Simone created to benefit Joseph then terminated, the net balances were distributed as she directed in her will.

The amount of the check enclosed with the letter was \$20,000, which, pending a complete accounting by the trustee, represents approximately 50% of the entire bequest.

This check was subsequently deposited in the money market fund that is held by Subud East Coast at PNC National Bank. This amount will remain in the money market fund until a determination is made as to how to best use this asset. One suggestion is to use the funds for low-interest loans on Subud housing in the East Coast Region.

We have been blessed in many ways by Joseph and Simone by their dedication and love for Subud and our Region, as I'm sure all who have known them personally can attest. To have received this bequest from their estate is a blessing beyond compare. We are all grateful and humbled by their

generosity and love.
